Council President Foster Opened Meeting

- Minutes approved from 05.11.21 by Council Brost and second by Council Brody

Police Department – Donna Musenbrock (represented)

- Marshal interviews are set up for June 21st at 5, 6, & 7 pm.
- Been driving the police car, it is running better with the new battery

Fire Department - Chief Kyle Brost-Present

- Fire Dept is in need of funds to repair the front of the building, resurface the parking lot, and etc. Council President Foster requested quotes

Water – Jim Turner- Present

- Repaired 3 water leaks in past 2 weeks and upgraded the service as well
- Going to be starting on the armory water service next
- Had to repair the skid steer
- Dollar General water problem has been fixed but Jim will talk with project manager about the over grown vegetation of the pond area
- Have the backflow preventer for the well that we will install ourselves. Will this affect our warranty on the new well? Curry and Ortman were going to put in at their cost for it was an IDEM requirement that was overlooked on their part. Council and Jim stated it has nothing to do with the well its self so warranty on well should not be hindered

Waste Water - Travis Barrett-Present

- Been helping Jim with water line repairs
- Brush got burnt
- Interested in the dual Water/WWTP license. Water license certification program through Alliance is a 2 year apprentice program. Council approved for Travis to attend Alliance Certification Program.
- Doors and Windows at the plant are possibly available financial coverage through the ARP (covid-19) grant

Park – Jake Martin- Present

- Been helping Jim with the water line repairs
- North side of the park is mulched, need more mulch
- Started patching a few holes, Council Member Brost requested to step up the pace on getting this accomplished

New Business

- David Buck with BF&S spoke in regards to the CCMG (grant), needs to be submitted between July 5 and July 30, Adams street is the top rated street for repair, different avenues that can be taken to make finances stretch farther such as chip N seal vs total reconstruct, If awarded the grant, funds will be held until January 2022, Council Member Brost recommended for approval to submit the application with Council President Foster second
- Mapping Tool is still available if interested, \$7200 per utility approx; eventually will need this to apply for grants; Council tabled until later
- Barb Simeon discussed her proposal of a campground on her property. It is called Boondocking, which they are not required to furnish water or sewer dumping. Council President Foster apologized for not getting back with her sooner but was unable to communicate with the other two council members and town attorney until this evening. With your property being within town limits, the council has agreed this would not be a viable decision for if we did it for you then who is to say someone in the center of town would want to do the same.


Old Business
