Fire Department - Chief Ryan Gillen-Present

- October 31st was our year end, had a total of 34 runs: 24 county and 10 in town

Water – Jim Turner-Present

- Got a load of salt and it is now blended with the de-icing sand
- Worked on a tile project out a WWTP
- Meters are insulated and working on equipment
- Councilmember Tolen asked Jim to get a plan of attack together to get the Legion and old town hall buildings torn down

Waste Water - Travis Barrett-Present –Present

- Looking at getting the valves in the basement replaced, couple at a time and couple on hand

Park – Jake Martin- Present

- Been working on the leaves and fixing salt spreader for this winter season
- Xmas decorations and banners can be put up week of Thanksgiving

New Business

- Resolution 2020-10 – Budget Reduction was motioned to for approval by Council Member Brost and second by Council Member Tolen
- Resolution 11.20.20 – Adopt the County’s Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan was motioned for approval by Council Member Brost and second by Council Member Tolen
- Council Member Brost Motioned to allow the county to have one of the partitions stored at the old town hall and second by Council Member Tolen
- Couple Patrons called with concerns on the elevator dust, Council was in agreement there is nothing that we can do to inforce the control of dust. They have been trying to water the gravel to help minimize the dust. Prior soybean oil was used but is not available
- Reminder leaf pickup is on Mondays, brush is over


