**Council President Foster Opened Meeting**

- Minutes approved from 7.13.21 and Special Meetings 7.19.21 by Council Brost and second by Council Brody

**Police Department – Coltin Clark (represented)**

- Been attending Marshal Academy online until able to go to the academy
- Council President asked Marshal Clark to tend to the paper work that is needed to keep us current on our guns

**Fire Department - Chief Kyle Brost-Present**

- Quote from Malhaupts was substantial for the interior doors of fire department, Brost said he would request for a couple other quotes to be gotten

**Water – Jim Turner- Present**

- Well #3 has lost compacity. Have a company coming out to test and inspect in 2-3 weeks. They will give us a print out of the condition and flow test results along with recommendations on what to fix before major problems occur
- Have had to do some repairs on the skid loader, maintenance on the mowers
- Working on the finalization of the quote on the plow and truck bed
- School is mind educating but going well; T3 Licensure

**Waste Water - Travis Barrett-Present**

- Cleaning out 2<sup>nd</sup> day pond, roughly 132k gallons, so far 26 loads, 6 loads a day and have about another week of pumping
- Attending Alliance Water School, classes are going good. Has 2 online courses to complete before October

**Park – Jake Martin- Not Present**

- Nothing to report

**New Business**

- American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund – Request of Payment  
Council President Foster signed the authorization, agreement to abide by terms and conditions, and the agreement to abide by the requirements
- Approval of GIS Utility Data for BF&S was approved by Council President Foster and second by Council Member Brody
- There will be a special meeting set to discuss the finalization of the golf cart ordinance, animal ordinance, and the nuisance ordinance: all of which need to be updated

**Old Business**


- Harold St Property Update: Kathy and Matt from the courthouse has been out to visit them; gave them until August 31 to make improvements; will re-address and get back with us at that time

**Patron Comments/Concerns**


