New Business

- BF&S-Dave Buck-CCMG Grant-Received two quotes for the resurfacing project of Spies St. Miles quote was \$75,449.00 and Reith & Riely's quote was \$59,594.10. Dave Buck will take the quotes and give an update at next meeting. Will have quotes ready to open for the Surface Seal project in March as well.
- Carl Chaifetz- INDOT- informed council that the bridge at Chase will be replaced in 2023. Also, INDOT is looking into making the intersection of 41 and 352 a J turn. Looking into how many crashes that have occurred warrants some changes. Once INDOT has all their information, there will be hearing on the matter for patron's to be heard. In regards to the flooding around 352, INDOT is projecting to lower State Rd 352, add drainage of 54-inch pipe that will go out to the Gillen ditch, and sidewalks along 352. Will need town to submit a non-matching grant to help cove sidewalk cost. INDOT will help apply for the grant.


