Council Member Brost Opened Meeting

- Approved Town Meeting Minutes 04.12.22, Councilman Brost motioned, Councilman Brody second

Police Department – Coltin Clark-Present

- Nicer Weather, please slow down and be aware of walkers, bikers, and golf carts
- Quote on stripping the Taurus Police Car came in at \$400.00 from Move Over Outfitters. Councilman Brost motioned to accept the quote with Council President second
- Approximately, 8 ordinance violations were sent out Monday via certified mail

Fire Department - Chief Kyle Brost-Present

- Want to remind everyone, there is no burning of trash, garbage or large amounts of brush.

Water – Jim Turner- Present

- Back up of tower controls is now running properly
- Almost have the CC flag pole finished, working on street patching, removed mound at the park, mowing

Waste Water - Travis Barrett-Present

- No fires, all is good

Park – Jake Martin-Present

- Street truck exhaust sensors malfunctioned today, left stranded, with Jim's help, did get it back to town
- Councilman Brost spoke with Dave Daulton, we can get divider blocks for sand, gravel, etc. for \$30 a block. Put a reserve on 12. Be available toward end of year. He will load but we have to transport from Attica.

New Business

- Resolution #222-0510 Surplus of Personal Property, regarding Ford Taurus Police car, Councilman Brost motioned to accept the resolution with Councilman Brody second
- Town wide garbage pick-up: Either dumpster service at \$3,000 or curbside service at \$4,375: Councilman Brost motioned to accept agreement on curbside pick-up with Republic Services with Councilman Brody second
- Quote from CM Construction to clean catch basins of \$2,840 was tabled. Council President would like to see additional charge to do 5 water valves, plus, investigate in renting the machine for a week at 1,200 for week per Councilman Brody

Old Business

- Street Sweeper-Councilman Brost has been talking with RJ Gillen at Bobcat to get a demo before purchasing. Currently, there is not one on the lot to demo. Checking with Sunbelt and Midwest Rentals to see if they have one
- Hot Box-Council President informed we were unable to get due to being out bided

- Dave Buck with BF&S was not scheduled to be in attendance but did update on the street resurfacing project. Need to get with Jim Turner and guys to set up a preconstruction meeting for May 24th


