- Shannon McLeod with Priority Project Resources, LLC – the town is needing a grant to help pay for a comprehensive plan, the cost is going to be around \$50,000, the grant will be from Indiana Office of Community & rural Affairs (OCRA) which will require a 10% project match, the next round for the grant that the town will be going for is August 18<sup>th</sup>
- Jim Turner brought up that our "New Tap Fees" are too low, the town needs to revise the ordinance

- Town Attorney Ingrid Barce needed clarification on how the new water rate increase is to be done, it was decided that there will be a 15% rate increase this year and then another 15% next year, Council Member Brost motioned, Council Member Foster second

**Patron Comments/Concerns**


- Linda Criswell had concerns about her driveway, she stated that when the roads were plowed there was damage done to her yard, Jim Turner is to look into it


