New Business


- Approved Ordinance #2022-0412 – Property Nuisance, Councilman Brost motioned, Councilman Brody second

Patron Comments/Concerns


- Linda Criswell inquired about what they are going to do the flooding at her house on Cook St., Council President Foster stated that there is work going to be done with it and said it was work in progress
