Council President Foster Opened Meeting

Police Department – Coltin Clark (represented)

- Coltin Clark was sworn in as new Town Marshal
- Next couple weeks, will be out meeting the community and making community aware that I am on duty

Fire Department - Chief Kyle Brost-Present

- Will be fixing some tiling at the Water/Street Department

New Business

- David Buck with BF&S spoke in regards to the CCMG (grant), needs to be submitted between July 5 and July 30, Adams street is the top rated street for repair, different avenues that can be taken to make finances stretch farther such as chip N seal vs total reconstruct, If awarded the grant, funds will be held until January 2022. Handed to Council the mapping of the PASOR Ratings/Cost Estimator for streets that are eligible for repair under grant. Council tabled decision on what streets and how to repair, will have special meeting to discuss further before the 31st of July.
- 2022 Budget Public Hearing and Adopt Budget dates were confirmed: 9/14 & 10/12
- Golf Cart Ordinance-need to implement a registration fee to help Marshal with who is in compliance of drivers, insurance, and following rules. Mini Bikes/4 wheelers will not be allowed. Gators are to be registered with the BMV. Donna will be reaching out to list serve on ordinance templates from other towns.
- Drainage Committee-George Doeden is on a 2 year term, Domingo Arredondo is on a 3 year term, and the 4 year term is open for appointment of seat by Council.
- Council Member Brody mentioned that he has been looking into the Town buying a backhoe

- Varmint control was brought up in regards to property on Harold St., Council is working on it but are having to proceed with protocol.


