Council President Brody Opened Meeting

- Approved Town Meeting Minutes 06.13.2023 Council Member Brost motioned, Council President Brody second

Public Hearing – Comprehensive Plan

- Shannon McLoed, Priority Project Grant Writer, presented a grant for the Comprehensive Plan. Will be filing for \$50,000 grant through OCRA to hire a town engineer to look at the towns infrastructure, housing, growth availability, business structures, vacant buildings/homes. They will be compiling a report with ideas and facts about where the town is now and where we would like to be in the future.
- July 31, we will need to have the engineers submit their qualifications; Aug 1 Qualifications need to be submitted to Shannon.
- Will need a scoring committee of least 3 and no more than 5 to narrow the engineer choices down to the best qualified


- Can we see about getting a bigger recycling container for Cardboard and moving recycling wagon back farther


