Police Department – Michael Marquess-Present

- Attended Marshal Association Conference for continuing training hours

Fire Department – Kyle Brost- Present

- We will be required to do our own flow testing for ISO each year
- There is no burning whatsoever except for fire pits with clean wood

Water – Jim Turner - Present

Wastewater - Travis Barrett –Present

- Had three pumps down; one clogged, one stopped up with rags, and the third the seal was broken

Park – Jake Martin – Not Present

- Jim will be fixing the slide window and the soft area on the foot meshing
- Travis got it mowed and sprayed the weeds

- Comprehensive Plan – Councilman Brost motioned to approve the 60 percent completion payment and second by Councilman Foster
- Greg Vogel with Vogel Realty presented a survey of the Laura Stakes Addition wanting the Town to consider covering the cost of putting utility mains in and they will pay for all the tapping fees

Patron Comments/Concerns:


- Linda Criswell inquired on when the street paving will begin along with the concern of the catch basin on corner of Smith and cook for when it fills up the water stands and bubbles


